- Financial assistance is available upon request, but you will be required to volunteer a minimum of 10 hours within the organization.
- No refunds will be issued after March 1, 2010. Exceptions may be made after a review by NPJBA board members.
- Registration fees pay for field development, league fees, insurance, umpires, tournaments, uniforms, and equipment.
- Donate your used cleats and mitts: If you have a pair of baseball shoes or a glove that you no longer need, bring them to sign-up night for re-use. Items may be exchanged or just donated. (Rubber soles only.)

## PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT CONTRACT

I, [ \_\_\_\_\_ ], as a parent of young athletes, understand the essential elements of character building and ethics are embodied in the six core principles of sportsmanship: trustworthiness, respect, responsibility, fairness, caring and good citizenship. My responsibilities are of great importance and my actions have the potential to influence the young athletes that observe my behavior. I also want the "NORTH PLAINS JUNIOR BASEBALL ASSOCIATION" to function with the highest possible standards for all of our participants. I therefore promise to conduct myself in accordance with the following code:

1. I (and my guests) will treat all players, coaches, parents, umpires, administrators and opponents with respect and dignity.
2. I will not encourage any behaviors or practices that will endanger the health and well-being of the athletes.
3. I will inform the coach of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of my child or the safety of others.
4. I will place the players first and the game second.
5. I will teach my child that doing one's best is more important than winning, so that my child will never feel defeated by the outcome of a game or his/her performance.
6. I will praise my child for competing fairly and trying hard and make my child feel like a winner every time.
7. I will never ridicule or yell at my child or other participants for making a mistake or losing a competition.
8. I will learn the rules of the game and the policies of the league.
9. I will teach my child to play by the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
10. I will demand that my child treat other players, coaches, officials and spectators with respect regardless of race, creed, color, sex or ability.
11. I will never physically or verbally abuse a player regardless of the situation.
12. I will never verbally abuse an umpire regardless of the situation.
13. I will not tolerate unsportsmanlike conduct from my child or guests.
14. I will refrain from coaching my child or other players during games and practices unless I am of one of the official coaches of the team.
15. I understand that my child is a member of a "team" and will make sure my child is at practice and at games on time and will contact the coach if my child is unable to attend practice or a game.
16. I will not use tobacco, alcohol or drugs during games or practice. Per JBO Rules, Section IV, Part C; No smoking, use of alcohol or drugs will be tolerated by any coach, player, fan, parent or umpire during games on the field. Also, the use of alcohol or drugs will not be tolerated by any Board member, coach, player, fan or parent before, during, or after practices on or around the playing field per North Plains Junior Baseball Association. Per Hillsboro School District Policy: Use of tobacco and alcohol are prohibited on school property. There is a zero tolerance policy, and I understand I will be asked to leave.
17. Most importantly, I will always ensure that my child maintains his/her right to have fun.
